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DEVELOPMENT OF PRODUCTS FOR THE PUBLIC SECTOR

SUMMED	TLT developed and implemented innovative, evidence-based interventions and training programs to support couples and families facing relational challenges, with a focus on accessibility and scalability. These efforts have reached thousands of couples and professionals across Denmark and internationally, driving measurable improvements in relationship health and therapeutic competencies.
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1. E-Therapy Program for Couples

- **Description:** Built a Danish version of an 8-week long digital therapy program for couples (developed by Professors Brian Doss and Andrew Christensen in the US at www.OurRelationship.com). The program focuses on strengthening emotional intimacy, communication and conflict behavior, using principles of Integrative Behavioral Couple Therapy (IBCT).
- **Role:** Lead Developer, collaborating with US program developers, Danish therapists, and software developers. Principle investigator on pilot RCT and ongoing RCT.
- **Impact:** Program adopted by family counseling agencies in **11 Danish municipalities**, supporting over **500 couples** in its first year.

2. Website for Public Awareness of Relationship Health

- **Description:** Initiated and collaborated on the development of an informative website, designed and launched by the NGO Center for Family Development, to promote healthy relationships. Contributed to the creation of evidence-based articles, self-assessment tools, and resources aimed at helping couples enhance their relationships.
- **Role:** Content Contributor and Quality Assurance Lead, ensuring accuracy, relevance, and usability of the website's materials.

3. Manual for Evidence-Based Brief Couple Counseling

- **Description:** Authored and validated a step-by-step manual for conducting structured brief interventions for couples experiencing varying degrees of relationship distress, using principles of Integrative Behavioral Couple Therapy (IBCT) and based on key elements from the **Marriage Checkup** by Professor James Cordova.

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- **Role:** Principal Author and Lead Researcher in piloting and testing the manual through trials and five-year follow-up results.
 - **Impact:** Over 200 therapists in Denmark and 150 therapists in Norway have been certified to use the manual, reaching more than 3,000 couples across these countries.

4. Digital Assessment Tool for Relationship Health

- **Description:** Created a digital tool for assessing relationship dynamics, including areas such as conflict communication, co-parenting, responsive attention, and sexual satisfaction.
- **Role:** Concept Developer and Researcher responsible for validation studies.
- **Impact:** Used by over 7,000 couples in Denmark and Norway, and by more than 300 individual therapists and family counseling agencies in 11 Danish municipalities, enabling quicker and more precise identification of areas for intervention in couple therapy.

5. Podcast: VoresParforhold [OurRelationship]

- **Description:** The podcast **VoresParforhold** explores the complexities of couple relationships, from moments of joy to periods of crisis. It delves into the ups and downs of love, focusing on underlying challenges couples face and providing lived experiences and evidence-based insights for navigating them.

6. IBCT Training Program – Aarhus University & University of Nîmes (2023–2024)

- **Description:** Designed and delivered multiple iterations of a postgraduate training program in **Integrative Behavioral Couple Therapy (IBCT)**, an evidence-based approach to couple therapy. The training program utilized a combination of fully virtual (Zoom-based) and hybrid formats to cater to international and local audiences.
- **Role:** Organizer, Trainer, and Clinical Supervisor, in collaboration with distinguished research professor Andrew Christensen from the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA). Responsible for curriculum development, facilitation, and ensuring integration of the latest IBCT research.
- **Impact:**
 - **International Iterations (2023):** First fully virtual iteration trained **77 professionals from 7 countries**, enhancing global access to IBCT expertise.
 - **Danish Iterations (2024):** Conducted **4 hybrid trainings** in Denmark, training over **100 local therapists**.
 - **University of Nîmes, France (2024):** Delivered an on-site iteration to a cohort of **35 participants**, focusing on adapting IBCT to French cultural contexts.
- **Example:** Across all nationalities, participants reported significant improvements in their therapeutic competencies, and **93% being interested in attending this or similar professional training again in the future** according to post-training evaluations.
- **Future Plans:** A second international virtual iteration is being planned for 2026, with additional in-person and hybrid sessions under development.

7. Public Sector Implementation Model

- **Description:** Designed and implemented a Stepped Care Model for family agencies to support parenting couples experiencing high conflict and distress. The model fosters task-sharing between NGOs, the public sector, and the university, integrating a range of evidence-based services tailored to the severity of issues. These services include digital tools, structured self-help resources, and evidence-based couple therapy (referencing products #1–#6 above).
- **Role:** Lead Developer and Project Coordinator. Responsible for designing the model, training therapists, and overseeing its implementation across multiple municipalities. Principle investigator on two research grants.
- **Impact:** Successfully implemented across **4 municipalities**, involving **20 therapists** and **1,161 users (parents)** in the first year. In 2025, **7 new municipalities** and **35 new therapists** are onboarded. The model, now supported by a grant from **Social- og Boligstyrelsen**, provides a scalable, evidence-based approach for municipalities to support parenting couples in distress, improving both relational and co-parenting dynamics.
- **Example:** The first data show that the model improves client utilization of couple therapy. As measured by pre- and post-intervention assessments, the model reduced conflict levels, improved co-parenting, and enhanced child adjustment.
