Profile and Ph.D. Project.

Employed Ph.D. fellow in an Open Call at the faculty of Arts, Department of Educational theory and curriculum studies, Material Culture, at Aarhus University, Copenhagen. My research project shares light on danish school architecture in a theoretical cross disciplinary perspective and is based on a profound experience with architectural and didactical practice.

Working as an architect and indoor designer I have been interested in the becoming of social life with the built environment and the users sensuous experience of materials and atmosphere. Teaching in ground school I have observed how the dialectics between the didactics and learning spaces produce social life and community in school. I scrutinize school architecture from the political becoming to the manifestation of human practices to the subtle experiences of the user.

Social sustainability with architecture and how qualitative methods can bring nuanced insight to the planning and post occupancy evaluation of welfare architecture is a main concern of mine. My project is framed historical to put light on danish school architecture programmed in 2015-2020. 2021 I have collected empirical material of didactical practices that arise with the built schools and the experiences of teachers and students at the schools taken in use.
